Paleontological Field School

24th August to 2th September 2019

The JURASSICA Museum together with the Institute of the Geological sciences of NAS of Republic of Armenia organizes ten days of paleontological field school in the late Miocene - Pleistocene site in Central Armenia. The fossil site provides rich fossiliferous horizons of vertebrate faunas with both aquatic and terrestrial forms including all vertebrate groups (fishes, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals). The fossiliferous horizons are related to lake and continental (paleosol, river canal) deposits.

Participants of the fieldwork will have the opportunity to gain experience in paleontological excavation techniques in different sediments, fossil «pre-preparation» in the field, documentation etc. The field excavation is organized in the framework of an ongoing research project and will be guided by researchers and a preparator.

Organization

We are seeking of up to 10 students (including PhD candidates) from universities or other academic institutions interested in the (vertebrate) paleontology from any country. The participants will receive a fixed transportation allowance (flight + train). Accommodation and food will be provided during the field work. The working language will be English.
